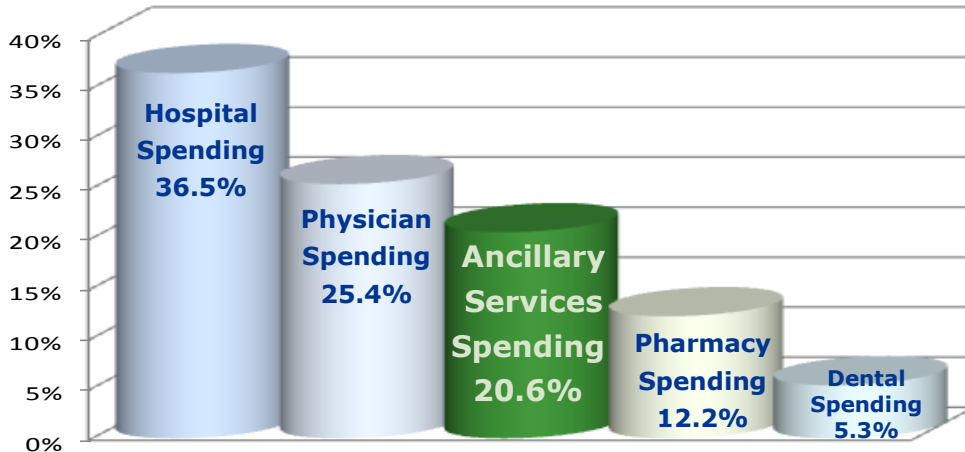


ACS Helps Manage Rising Ancillary Care Costs



A 2008 study conducted by the National Coalition of Health Care reported that the total national healthcare expenditure was \$2.4 trillion, or \$7,900 per person in the US. Of that \$7,900 per person, ancillary care services (laboratories, diagnostic imaging, and 26 other specialties) accounted for 20.6%, which is more than pharmaceuticals (12.2%) and dental (5.3%) spending combined.*

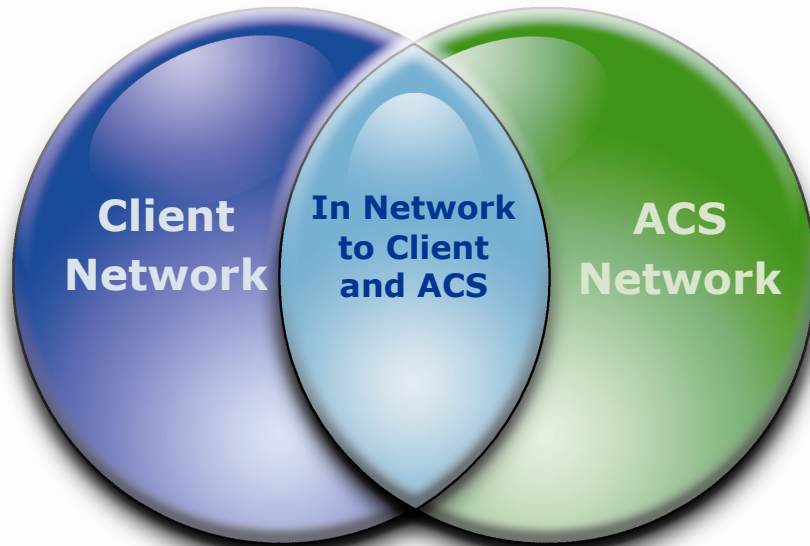
